SPECIAL DAYS:

February 2nd: FEAST OF THE PRESENTATION. On this coming Friday, 40 Days after the Solemnity of the Nativity of the Lord, the Church celebrates the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord also known as Candlemas Day. This 40th Day is the official end of "Christmastide" and the final day to display the images of the Holy Family in the Crèche. As this was the day on which Christ is revealed to Simeon as a light to the nations, then it is the traditional day to bless candles for use in the church and in the home. The Candles blessed on the Feast of the Presentation are then used on the following day, February 3rd, for the Blessing of Throats on the Feast of St. Blaise. Throats will be blessed at the conclusion of the 8:30 AM First Saturday Mass.

TRAVELS:

In response to numerous inquiries about where the next pilgrimage destination may be, the answer is ITALY in the late winter/early spring of 2019. At present, the NAWAS Agency is trying to arrange the best itinerary for the best price for a journey that will start in the lakes region of Northern Italy and move south with the final destination being Rome. En route to the Eternal City, the group will visit Venice, Padua, Florence, Siena, Assisi, and Orviedo. Although Italians will likely be bundled up in winter attire, the temperatures can be very moderate and pleasant at this time of year and the crowds are definitely much smaller and hopefully the hotels are less expensive! So stay tuned for further information. In the meantime, for those interested in the Holy Land, Fr. Healey will be traveling there in October as a pil-

grim rather than a shepherd on a pilgrimage organized by Fathers Walter Carreiro and Albert Capone of the Archdiocese of Boston. The trip will be guided by the best Christian guide known to the Holy Land, Anton Farah, who at age 86 limits himself to the number of groups he will take. So, this pilgrimage comes highly recommended and Fr. Healey would be happy to have any who desire to experience the Fifth Gospel to join with him as pilgrims on this pilgrimage rather than waiting for two or more years until he organizes another; please contact Fr. Healey for further information.

PREPARING FOR LENT:

Lent begins in just over two weeks with Ash Wednesday being February 14th this year. As we did last year, we will designate some charities as recipients of the monetary fruits of our Lenten sacrifices. Last year, we provided resources to our own St. Vincent de Paul Society and Catholic Relief Services, but also to either Catholic Near East Welfare Association, and the Seminarians of Tanzania. This year, in addition to St. Vincent de Paul and Catholic Relief, we will have the option of supporting a special building project in Guatemala in which one of our own parishioners, Dr. Nicholas Matas, is personally involved. Dr. Matas will explain this project to us at the end of the weekend Masses on February 3rd and 4th. Each one of us should discern how and what we will sacrifice both as a form of fasting and as a means of greater alms giving during Lent. For instance, if someone decides to give up evening cocktails during Lent, then they should estimate what money they did not spend on their favorite liquor for 40 days and be willing to give that to the charities designated in whatever manner and amount they prefer - evenly divided among all three, or all to one or two. In this way, we live the Paschal mystery by dying to self in order to give life to another. Designating the charities for our parish allows us to all be in this together rather than merely as individuals, and enables us to make a bigger difference in the lives of others in this way.

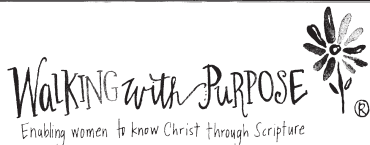
