All Residents 18 years of age and older.

COST?

FREE

The Mashpee Board of Health, in cooperation with the Visiting Nurse's Association of Cape Cod and the Mashpee Council on Aging, will hold the vaccination clinics.

FLU VACCINE IS AVAILABLE FOR:

• Uninsured individuals • Medicare Part B Participants • All other insurances.

PRECAUTIONS: Some people should check with a doctor before taking influenza vaccine:

• Persons with a history of egg allergy who have experienced only hives after exposure to egg SHOULD receive influenza vaccine.

• History of Guillain-Barre Syndrome within 6 weeks of receipt of influenza vaccine.

Women who might be or are pregnant.

• Persons who are ill and have a fever should delay vaccination until the fever and other temporary symptoms are gone.

• Asthma in persons aged 5 years and older; or medical conditions which might predispose to higher risk for complications attributable to influenza (e.g., chronic pulmonary disease, cardiovascular disease (except isolated hypertension), renal, hepatic, neurologic hematologic or metabolic disorders (including diabetes).

• If you are taking antibiotics at the time of the flu clinic, you CANNOT receive a flu shot.

Individuals enrolled in Medicare B MUST bring their cards with them for registration and reimbursement purposes. Participants without Medicare B are still eligible to receive the Flu Shot.
