



## Walking with Purpose Monthly Perpetual Prayer Calendar

- 1** That the women of Walking with Purpose would see your glory  
“And the word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we have seen his glory, glory as of the only son from the Father, full of grace and truth.” John 1:14
- 2** That every woman in WWP would have a personal relationship with you  
“Jesus replied, ‘If anyone loves me, he will obey my teaching. My Father will love him, and we will come to him and make our home with him.’” John 14:23
- 3** That the women of WWP would experience inner transformation  
“And we, who with unveiled faces all reflect the Lord’s glory, are being transformed into his likeness with ever-increasing glory, which comes from the Lord, who is the Spirit.”  
2 Corinthians 3:18
- 4** That the women of WWP would walk in freedom  
“Now the Lord is the Spirit, and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is freedom.”  
2 Corinthians 3:17
- 5** That the women of WWP would be quick to confess their sins  
“If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness.” 1 John 1:9
- 6** That the women of WWP would know the difference between conviction and condemnation. Protect them from the voice of the evil one  
“My sheep listen to my voice. I know them, and they follow me.” John 10:27
- 7** That the women of WWP would be equipped to pass on the faith to the next generation  
“Fix these words of mine in your hearts and minds; tie them as symbols on your hands and bind them on your foreheads. Teach them to your children, talking about them when you sit at home and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up.”  
Deuteronomy 11:18-19



- 8** That the women of WWP who are married would be strengthened and protected in their marriage  
"Above all, love each other deeply, because love covers a multitude of sins." 1 Peter 4:8
- 9** That genuine, authentic friendships would grow among the women of WWP  
"The righteous choose their friends carefully, but the way of the wicked leads them astray." Proverbs 12:26
- 10** That the Holy Spirit would inspire Lisa's writing to reflect creative truth-telling that draws hearts to Christ  
"But he said to me, 'My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness.' Therefore I will boast all the more gladly of my weaknesses, so that the power of Christ may rest upon me." 2 Corinthians 12:9
- 11** That God's truth would travel like an arrow into the hearts of the WWP women, bearing the fruit that God desires to see  
"For the word of God is alive and active. Sharper than any double-edged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart." Hebrews 4:12
- 12** That the relationships between the WWP leaders and women and their pastors would be positive and strong  
"And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds." Hebrews 10:24
- 13** That WWP would be a blessing to the parishes where it is found  
"Speaking the truth in love, we will grow to become in every respect the mature body of him who is the head, that is, Christ. From him the whole body, joined and held together by every supporting ligament, grows and builds itself up in love, as each part does its work." Ephesians 4:15-16
- 14** For clarity of thought among WWP leadership and a freedom from confusion and division  
"That the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give to you a spirit of wisdom and of revelation in the knowledge of Him." Ephesians 1:17



- 15** For protection over the WWP board members, and that God would fill them with wisdom and discernment  
"Let us not lose heart in doing good, for in due time we will reap if we do not grow weary." Galatians 6:9
- 16** That all women in WWP would have their identity and worth rooted firmly as beloved daughters of God  
"The Spirit himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God." Romans 8:16
- 17** That all women in WWP would be filled with the Holy Spirit  
"And when they had prayed, the place where they had gathered together was shaken, and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak the word of God with boldness." Acts 4:31
- 18** That the women of WWP would be so different in terms of the way they love (through words and actions) that Christ would be seen and lifted high  
"By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another." John 13:35
- 19** For a willingness to engage in healthy conflict among the WWP leadership teams  
"There is one who speaks rashly like the thrusts of a sword, but the tongue of the wise brings healing." Proverbs 12:18
- 20** Humility among all WWP leaders  
"Instead, the greatest among you should be like the youngest, and the one who rules like the one who serves." Luke 22:26
- 21** Growth at the pace YOU desire, Lord  
"If we live by the Spirit let us keep in step with the Spirit." Galatians 5:25



- 22** Provision for the financial needs of the ministry  
“And my God will meet all your needs according to the riches of his glory in Christ Jesus.” Philippians 4:19
- 23** For a ministry culture that exudes an outpouring of love for women  
“Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud. It does not dishonor others, it is not self-seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs.” 1 Corinthians 13:4-5
- 24** For a ministry culture that exudes fearless positivity  
“With men this is impossible; but with God all things are possible.” Matthew 19:26
- 25** For a ministry culture that is filled with beauty and creativity that breaks down barriers  
“To bestow on them a crown of beauty instead of ashes, the oil of joy instead of mourning, and a garment of praise instead of a spirit of despair. They will be called oaks of righteousness, a planting of the Lord for the display of his splendor.” Isaiah 61:3
- 26** For a ministry culture that celebrates our littleness while dreaming big with God  
“He has told you, o man, what is good. And what does the Lord require of you but to do justice, love mercy, and walk humbly with your God?” Micah 6:8
- 27** For a ministry culture that is dedicated to the small necessary tasks because of our belief in the big picture of God's work  
“Whoever can be trusted with very little can also be trusted with much, and whoever is dishonest with very little will also be dishonest with much.” Luke 16:10
- 28** For protection over us all from the spirit of discouragement  
“The Lord Himself goes before you and will be with you. He will never leave you nor forsake you. Do not be afraid. Do not be discouraged.” Deuteronomy 31:8



- 29** For renewal in the Catholic Church today  
“If my people, who are called by my name, will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and I will forgive their sin and will heal their land.”  
2 Chronicles 7:14
- 30** For all our women to step out of their comfort zones to love women to Christ  
“For God gave us a spirit not of fear but of power and love.” 2 Timothy 1:7
- 31** May Walking with Purpose shine as a light in the darkness  
“For God, who said, ‘Let light shine out of darkness,’ made his light shine in our hearts to give us the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Christ.” 2 Corinthians 4:6
