TO BE OR NOT TO BE:

On this Sunday following the 10:30 AM Mass, you are welcome to come to the parish hall for a lite collation and then a presentation by Bobby Schindler who through personal experience is well qualified to speak about the issue of euthanasia. This talk is not only an appropriate way to start Pro-Life Month but also an opportunity to become better informed about this pressing matter as the Massachusetts Legislature again takes up the question of whether or not to permit physician assisted suicide, and this even after the voters rejected this option in a statewide referendum in 2012.

MARKING AN ANNIVERSARY / MAKING HISTORY:

On Sunday, November 5, 2017 at 3:00 PM, a special ecumenical prayer service will be held in the Cathedral Church of St. Mary on the corner of Spring and Second Streets in Fall River to mark the 500th Anniversary of the beginning of the Protestant Reformation. Bishop Edgar da Cunha, Roman Catholic Bishop of the Diocese of Fall River will preside at the service and Bishop James Hazelwood of the Evangelical Lutheran Synod of New England will preach. As we mark this significant anniversary of this pivotal moment in the history of Western Christianity, we will also be making history as this 5th century observance is taking place in the context of 50 years of ecumenical dialogue and cooperation. Protestants and Catholics can now gather in prayer together not only to remember the origins of their divisions but most especially to celebrate their ongoing progress along the path toward greater unity over the past five decades. All Christians throughout Southeastern Massachusetts, Protestant and Catholic, and their clergy, are welcome and encouraged to participate in this special service which will be both historic and healing.

On November 5th, you are invited to join Fr. Healey on a bus trip to St. Mary's Cathedral in Fall River to participate in the Ecumenical Prayer Service commemorating the 500th anniversary of the beginning of the Reformation. A lite lunch will be served in the hall at 12:30 PM and the bus will depart at 1:15 PM in order to arrive in time for the 3:00 PM service.
