Yet, the more recent trend in parish missions is the idea of a preached retreat which you don't have to journey too far in order to enjoy. This retreat that we begin this weekend and which will continue through Wednesday evening is being preached by Deacon Greg Kandra, a well known author, blogger, editor and speaker, whose primary qualifications for delivering a message to both inspire and challenge us to further spiritual growth is that he is a man of deep Christian faith. Three mornings from 8:30 to 9:30 AM or three evenings from 7:00 to 8:00 PM, is all that is required of your time; perhaps this is the time that the Lord will use to speak to you through Deacon Greg and bring about an unexpected change of mind and heart. The sacrament of Penance will be


available before the Mission on Tuesday evening from 6-7 PM and immediately following it as well from 8 to 9 PM.

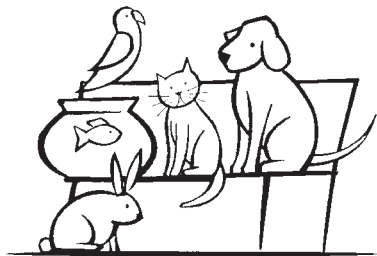


**BEREAVEMENT

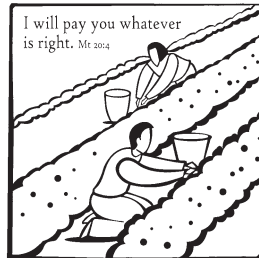
