THE THIRTEENTH DAY: In commemoration of the 100th anniversary of the final apparition of Our Lady at Fatima on October 13th, 1917, the recent film entitled THE 13th DAY will be shown in the parish hall on this Friday morning following the 8:30 AM Mass. The film will assist in reminding us of what occurred a century ago in the small village of Fatima in Portugal and how thousands witnessed "the miracle of the sun" as evidence of the authenticity of these apparitions of the Blessed Virgin.

IN THE NEAR FUTURE:

AN AFTERNOON WITH TOM BOOTH: Join composer Tom Booth and keyboardist Carl Herrgesell for an afternoon of Praise and Worship on Sunday, October 22nd at 3:00 PM, at St. Anthony's Church, 167 East Falmouth Hwy., East Falmouth, MA. A free will offering will be taken. Tom and Carl will also offer a 2-night parish mission at St. Anthony's on Monday and Tuesday, October 23rd and 24th at 7:00 PM. All are welcome.

MARKING AND ANNIVERSARY / MAKING HISTORY: On Sunday, November 5, 2017, at 3:00 PM, a special ecumenical prayer service will be held in the Cathedral Church of St. Mary, on the corner of Spring and Second Streets in Fall River to mark the 500th Anniversary of the beginning of the Protestant Reformation. Bishop Edgar da Cunha, Roman Catholic Bishop of the Diocese of Fall River, will preside at the service and Bishop James Hazelwood of the Evangelical Lutheran Synod of New England will preach. As we mark this significant anniversary of this pivotal moment in the history of Western Christianity, we will also be making history as this 5th centenary observance is taking place in the context of 50 years of ecumenical dialogue and cooperation. Protestants and Catholics can now gather in prayer together not only to remember the origins of their divisions but most especially, to celebrate their ongoing progress along the path toward greater unity over the past five decades. All Christians throughout Southeastern Massachusetts, Protestant and Catholic, and their clergy, are welcome and encouraged to participate in this special service which will be both historic and healing.
