Catholic Charities Appeal:

Mailings are being sent out and will be received by all registered households regarding the annual appeal from our bishop, the Most Reverend Edgar da Cunha, requesting our assistance in helping him to fund the pastoral, charitable, social, catechetical and ministerial activities and agencies that operate throughout the Diocese of Fall River. Here on Cape Cod we are blessed to have the St. Joseph Shelter for the Homeless, the Chaplaincies at Cape Cod and Falmouth Hospitals, and the Apostolates to newly arrived Catholics from Latin America, all of which depend greatly on the funds raised by this annual appeal.

As Catholics in the United States, we have always been well known for our charitable efforts, both on the parish and Diocesan level, and that is how it should be as we profess our faith in Jesus Christ who has revealed the compassion of God for all people especially who are struggling in any way or suffering from any need.

So let us answer our bishop's call to assist him in keeping this proud charitable tradition alive in the Diocese of Fall River by giving generously as our means allow to the annual Catholic Charities Appeal which begins on May 1st and continues through the end of June. One time donations or pledges which may be paid over a 10-month period can be made by using the envelopes provided in the mailing or at the entrances to the church and returning these in the collection basket on weekends or to the parish office before the end of the appeal; payment by credit card may be made on-line via the Diocesan website.

Shock and Loss:

To hear the news that a police officer was shot and killed in the line of duty, perhaps sadly, isn't all that uncommon as to shock us, but to hear the news that this happened here on Cape Cod somehow was quite unnerving. We might expect such terrible news to come to us from larger metropolitan areas, but not on the quiet Cape that we all love so well.

Then, the terrible loss was brought all that much closer to home as we learned that this young officer was the son of a very committed Catholic couple, Patrick and Denise Morency Gannon, well known to many of the clergy of the Diocese of Fall River through their involvement in various ministries and Denise's work as a pastoral musician. Sean Gannon was a good and decent young man who sought work in law enforcement to truly protect and serve the public as do so many who choose this field as their career, and such a choice would not be unusual considering the example of service Sean received at home in his formative years.

Now, Sean Gannon leaves a young widow, grieving parents and siblings, colleagues and a shocked and saddened general public, especially those of us on Cape Cod whose peace has truly been disturbed by this terrible injustice. Let us keep all who are personally affected by this tragic loss in our prayers as well as all those who serve us as first responders, truly putting their lives on the line for us every day as we have had to learn anew in the hardest possible way this past week.
