First Holy Eucharist: On next Sunday at 12:15 PM, a special Mass will be celebrated at which some of the young people of our parish will take their next step in the process toward full initiation into the church by receiving the Eucharist for the first time. While this is a very special day in the lives of these young people and their families, it is a celebration of the whole church rather than an exclusion event, so all parishioners are most welcome to participate as well.

Catholic Charities Appeal: The annual Catholic Charities Appeal opens officially on May 1st. This is our yearly opportunity to encourage and support our bishop as he seeks to continue to fund the many charitable and apostolic works that are carried out by the church in the name of all the Catholic people of our diocese. Materials for the appeal have been mailed to all registered households and additionally, there are always extra envelopes for the Appeal on the tables at the entrances to the church.

Pledges or donations may be returned by placing these in the collection basket or otherwise returning them to the parish office before the close of the appeal on the last Wednesday in June.

It is also possible to donate on line through the website for the Diocese of Fall River. The video recorded to inform us of all that the appeal helps the church to accomplish may be viewed on our parish website and will also be played in the Parish Hall.

From Death Comes Life: Three charities were designated to benefit from the funds we saved by setting these aside rather than spending them on ourselves during Lent. These were collected mainly

at the preparation rite at the Evening Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday and have also come in on Easter Sunday and beyond.

The El Tablon Housing Construction Project has received \$3,124.50; the St. Vincent de Paul Society of our own parish \$3,667.50; and the Catholic Relief Services Rice Bowl \$825.00. Surely, this is a clear sign of the Paschal Mystery that from death comes life as our dying to ourselves through self denial and sacrifice during Lent is enabling us to bring life and blessings to many people in need in this season of Easter. Gratitude is due to all who understand and embrace Lenten fasting in all it forms as something that can be life giving not only to us, but especially to others.

A Note of Gratitude: Thanks to all who contributed to the moving expenses of the three Religious Sisters, because of your generosity each was awarded \$2,250.00 to help them with the many costs that they will incur at this time of transition.

A Request for Help: The Catholic Prison Ministry would greatly appreciate alms in the form of plain note cards, holiday or birthday cards that they could provide to those incarcerated at the Barnstable County Correctional Facility in order to allow them to correspond with their family and friends on special occasions. (The cards cannot have glitter, strings or stickers attached). Keeping family ties and maintaining healthy friendships is often crucial to being able to successfully transition back from incarceration to life on the outside again when that time comes. JOSEPH OF NAZARETH: The Bible gives us intriguing glimpses of Joseph but leaves much in mystery. We know that he was a just man, loving and compassionate in dealing with the events of the divine conception and virgin birth. He also accepted the incredible challenges of protecting and raising Jesus as head of the Holy Family.

This DVD about the man closest to Christ brings him alive by placing him in the historical context of his time.

BOOMERANG and Other Easter Stories by Fr. Chester Wrzaszczak. In this heart-warming book, Fr. Chester tells ten stories based on his Depression-era childhood. A first-generation Polish-American, he grew up in Chicago, was the first in his family to finish high school and served 43 years as priest and pastor.
