The Feast of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ:

The Feast we celebrate today had its origins during the Pontificate of Urban IV who took what had been a feast celebrated in various parts of Europe and legislated it to be observed by the entire church beginning in 1264. Pope Urban enlisted the skill of a Dominican theologian, Thomas Aquinas, to compose the hymns for the Office and Mass of this Feast and we still sing these hymns today as Pange Lingua, Tantum Ergo, Adore Te Devote, and O Salutaris in traditionally Catholic cultures. The feast is observed as a holiday on the Thursday following Trinity Sunday, and in those places like the United States where it is not a holiday, the celebration is moved to the following Sunday.

Thus where possible, the feast serves to make another Thursday holy by celebrating the precious gift of the Eucharist as the true Body and Blood of Jesus Christ given to nourish God's people. This is done realizing that on Holy Thursday this is not the only theme in the liturgical celebration and so it is worth reiterating that important message of Christ's true presence as it may get overshadowed by the emphasis on his passion during the Sacred Triduum.

Thus in all the masses this weekend, we pause to contemplate the truth that in the Eucharist the body and blood of Christ are truly present under the appearances of bread and wine. In order to honor so great a sacrament, we will hold a procession at the conclusion of the 10:30 AM Mass followed by a period of adoration in St. Jude's Chapel concluding with Benediction at 5:15 PM.

Priestly Ordination: On next Saturday, June 9th, Deacon Daniel Nunes who served a pastoral year here at Christ the King Parish, will be ordained a priest along with two others at the Cathedral of St. Mary in Fall River. As sufficient interest has been indicated, a bus will leave the parish at 9:15 AM, to travel to Fall River for the 11 AM Mass of Ordination, and return here approximately at 2 PM. There is still limited space available on the bus.

Please register with the parish office if you wish to attend.

Catholic Charities Appeal: As May turns to June, all parishioners are reminded that these are the months during which the Annual Catholic Charities Appeal is conducted by the Diocese of Fall River to support the many pastoral and charitable works of the Church throughout South-eastern Massachusetts, Cape Cod and the Islands.

Thus far, 261 households of our parish have pledged or contributed \$61,398. Our hope is that every household of the parish will respond to Bishop da Cunha's request to assist him in funding the good works that are carried out all year long in the name of all the Catholic people in the Diocese of Fall River.

Materials for the Appeal are available at the entrances of the Church. Please remember that all pledges and donations must be made on or before Wednesday, June 27th.

Summer Raffle: With the influx of visitors during the Summer season, various parish groups were naturally scheduling fund raisers, such that it seemed that hardly was their weekend in July or August when one wasn't being promoted in some way or another.

Thus to simplify this, and also help our organizations such as The Catholic Women's Club, the Knights of Columbus, St. Vincent de Paul and the parish itself to raise money for various activities, we will have one Summer Raffle from which these organizations will benefit. The grand prize will be \$5,000, and \$5,000 more in additional prizes of various amounts will be awarded. Tickets will be mailed to all registered households and will be available after all Masses in July and August. Your support will be greatly appreciated!
