WELCOME BACK: With Memorial Day Weekend, we officially begin the busier season on Cape Cod as many more seasonal residents have recently returned from warmer climates and vacationing visitors are beginning to come back to the Cape. Let us pray that the weather finally cooperates with the calendar!

We welcome you and thank you for the witness to faith that your presence at Mass indicates, your faithfulness to Mass even when on vacation it is an inspiration to all of us who are here throughout the year.

WE'VE GONE A LITTLE GREENER: A change you may notice as you return is that we've switched from disposable missals to a hard cover and thus more permanent one. Such a switch is certainly more environmentally responsible, and that is something that we are called to be as stewards of all God's creation. In the past, large volumes of paper became obsolete with each change of season in the church year, and so the missalettes ended up in the dumpster. After the initial investment for these new missals, the parish will be saving money as well in the long run as we hope that with respectful use and care as befits a book that contains the Word of God and the prayers of the Liturgy, these missals will serve us for better than a decade to come. Missals can be memorialized; the forms for this can be found on the narthex tables at the entrances to the church; this is a wonderful way to remember someone who has died or to honor someone who is still living by donating a missal in their name. We ask that you open the dedication page of the missal you are using at each Mass to remember the person for whom it was dedicated also, and the donor in your prayers. While the new missals may be a bit heavier than the disposable ones, this seems a small penance to patiently endure in exchange for the benefit to the environment, the savings to the parish, and the dignity to the ambiance of the church itself that these new missals afford.

Rather than page numbers, every item contained in the missal is numbered beginning with the liturgical prayers in the beginning through the hymns in the middle and to the scriptural readings in back. The Lector will

announce the numbers before Mass begins; we would be grateful if you would take care to mark the relevant pages with the ribbons provided, if this has not yet already been done by someone before you. The missals remind us that the Sunday readings are on a three-year cycle A-B-C. While there is often one set of readings for the various feasts of the Church Year, on Sundays of Ordinary Time, Advent, Lent, and Easter, there are three sets; during the year 2018 through to the Feast of Christ the King in late November, we are using the readings of Year B.

FIRST FRIDAY/FIRST SATURDAY DEVOTIONS: We are making a slight change in our observances of First Friday and First Saturday. For security reasons and difficulty in obtaining consistent commitments of a sufficient number of adorers during the night and early morning hours, we have decided to shorten the period of adoration on First Friday to 8 hours. The Blessed Sacrament will be exposed in St. Jude's Chapel on each First Friday beginning with the conclusion of the 8:30 AM Mass and continuing until 4:50 PM with Benediction. First Saturday Mass will continue but will consistently be on the First Saturday of the calendar month rather than the Saturday after First Friday; this should help to avoid any confusion as occurred at times in the past when the first day of the month fell on Saturday, but the Mass was not held until the following week because of First Friday. We encourage you to commit to an hour of adoration before the Blessed Sacrament on First Friday. You may indicate your willingness to do so by informing the parish office.

ADORERS are still needed on next Sunday, the Feast of the Most Precious Body and Blood of Christ, from the conclusion of the 10:30 AM Mass until 5:15 PM. Please leave your name and time of your commitment with the parish office.

ALTAR SERVER/ RECRUITMENT: Any of those who have now received their First Communion are eligible to become Altar Servers. Those who are interested should give their name to one of the priests or deacons, to Chris Hughes or the parish office. A training class will form once names have been received.
