Feasts of Late June: On this Sunday, six months before Christmas Eve, we celebrate the birth of St. John the Baptist.

The date of the feast in the Church Calendar is obviously determined by the message of Gabriel to Mary at the Annunciation that her relative, Elizabeth, was already in her 6th month. The feast also comes just after the Summer Solstice, when the light starts ever so subtly to decrease each day mirroring the Baptist's self-understanding "I must decrease, He must increase".

Later this week, on the 29th, the Church celebrates the Feast of St. Peter and St. Paul, the two apostles who are the strongest pillars of the original church of Jesus Christ.

By the mid 60's of the first century both of these apostles had eventually found their way to Rome and there they die a martyr's death, Peter by crucifixion and Paul by the sword.

There is an ancient understanding that for Christian faith and practice to be orthodox in the broadest sense it is dependent upon what was handed down to us from the apostles and in particular, these two "princes" of the apostles.

So, it is that because their tombs are in Rome, Peter's under the famous basilica that bears his name, and Paul's in another basilica outside what were the original walls of Rome, that our bishops are required to visit that city and make a pilgrimage to these tombs every five years.

Praying at the graves of Peter and Paul, bishops, and hopefully all the faithful, are reminded that living the authentic faith that Jesus intended us to live is utterly dependent upon our connectedness to the apostles, and our fidelity to what they taught and practiced. This is what we mean when each Sunday we profess our faith in a church that is "apostolic" for if it were otherwise, it could not be the true church of Jesus Christ.
