SUMMER SPEAKER 2018: Christ the King Church / Tuesday, July 17th at 7PM: Fr. Benedict Kiely, a priest of the Diocese of Burlington, Vermont, who is the founder of NASAREAN.org., a charity whose concern is the plight of Christians in the troubled areas of the Middle East, will be the guest speaker at an event sponsored by the Catholic Churches of Falmouth, Mashpee, Osterville and Centerville, to which all are invited.

Unfortunately, for various reasons, the major media outlets in the United States do not always report the full story of the sufferings of Christians at the hands of radical islaminsts in parts of the Middle East.

Through his visits to Iraq and Syria, Fr. Ben has seen firsthand the situation of our brothers and sisters in faith in these lands and will relate his experiences to us in what is certain to be a most interesting and informative presentation.

“CATHOLICISM”: A 50-minute episode from this informative and inspirational series by Bishop Robert Barron will be shown each Sunday during the summer following the 10:30 AM Mass in Classroom A. Come enjoy a cup of coffee as you deepen your formation as a Catholic Christian.

A VERY SPECIAL PROJECT: The beautiful St. Jude Chapel, moved to this parish complex from Cotuit, is not only a historic building, but one which holds a special place in the hearts and memories of those who often worshipped in it before the building of Christ the King Church in 1989, or who have celebrated sacred milestones and moments in it since.

Renewed upon its arrival here, now nearly 30 years ago, it is time to do so again! The Chapel interior and some of its furnishings have already been repainted during this past winter and spring, and the sanctuary furnishings have been reupholstered, but there is still other work to be done including:

- **Replacing the pressed board bench of the pews with hardwood, repainting and re-staining the pews. (\$18,500)**
- **Acquiring new removable and reversible pew cushions – (\$3,720)**
- **Creating a Baptistry out of the former Confessional – (\$12,600)**
- **Installing an amplification system with microphones for the celebrant, lector, and cantor.**
- **Replacing the carpeting.**

Estimates are being sought for the completion of this work or are listed in parenthesis where already known. Donations and special gifts are needed to proceed with this work and will be gratefully received in envelopes marked “Chapel”; memorial gifts are also possible and can be arranged by contacting the office.

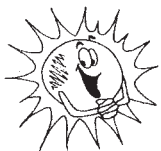

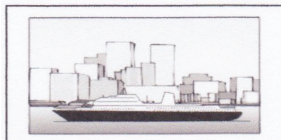
