**Adult Bible Study:** Class resumes this weekend immediately following the 10:30AM Sunday Mass in the St. Jude chapel.

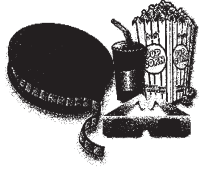
