The Pastor's Pen

THE WEEKLY COLUMN BY FR. EDWARD HEALEY



Repentance: the Essential Work of Lent: The caricature of Repentance is the instantaneous Tent Revival conversion, where in a dramatic moment, the hardened sinner suddenly becomes one of the forever saved! Yet authentic repentance has little to do with such sudden and dramatic conversions as indicated by the very word itself which means a rethinking, that is, of our own thoughts, attitudes, beliefs and behaviors in light of the Commandments of God to see where further corrections are necessary in accord with any new insights we may have acquired as to a deeper meaning and broader implications of God's law. Truly, repentance is not a "one and done" phenomenon, for from early adulthood onward, repentance should be something with which we are familiar, a discipline that, as spiritually mature persons, we have engaged in at least once each year, ideally in the midst of a penitential season like Lent! So if the coming of Lent has taken us a bit by surprise this past week and we have not yet paused sufficiently to begin repenting, then let us start now lest this short season of 40 days pass quickly. We find ourselves with minimal progress in the process of ongoing conversion, of which repentance is one of the essential tools. Once we find ourselves turning back to the Lord and examining our lives with complete honesty in light of His Law, - then let us express our sincere contrition at having failed where we have, as we come with a sincere desire to change to the Sacrament of Reconciliation. It is in that sacrament that our slate can be wiped clean, and appropriately, we accept the obligation to make up for our sins by doing penance over the course of Lent specifically by engaging in additional prayer, embracing the discipline of fasting and self-denial, and directing the cost of what we willingly deny ourselves to alleviate the sufferings of the poor. In this way, we will arrive at Holy Thursday, renewed to be able to truly pass over with Christ from the death that is sin to the new life in Christ that we celebrate in the Easter Triduum!

Introduction to the Gospels: Sundays from 9:30 AM to 10:20 AM or 4:15 to 5:15 PM in the Parish Hall: In this Lenten Adult Formation Session we will be viewing presentation by Dr. Brant Pitre on the basics of the Four Canonical Gospels of Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John learning their origins, addressing their questions of their authorship and their similarities and differences. Dr. Pitre does not disappoint as he is an outstanding but very easy-to-understand teacher of Scripture.

Our Work in Guatemala: Last Lent, one of the three charities designated to be the beneficiary of our Lenten Alms Giving included the efforts of Cross Catholic Outreach to build basic and decent homes for people in Guatemala whose dwellings offer little protection from the elements. Along with Catholic Relief Services, and Matthew 25 2e will continue to designate this particular project to receive a third of the alms collected from parishioners at the end of Lent as the fruit of our self-denial. This weekend, Dr. Nicholas Matas will update us on what our alms giving has helped to accomplish in Guatemala so far, and what further needs to be accomplished.

Will You Sign Up? Each Friday in Lent, there will be Exposition and Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament from 9AM to 4 PM in the Chapel. While everyone is free to come and go as they are able, we do need to be certain that there is someone there throughout the day so that the Monstrance is never left unattended. Forms with half-hour time slots are being passed around the church this morning in hopes that many will sign on the dotted line to be commit themselves to be there at a certain time on each of the Fridays of Lent.

Confirmation for Adults: Are you an adult 18 or over who has not yet been Confirmed? We welcome you to consider being Confirmed with other Adults at the Cathedral Of St. Mary in Fall River on the 29th of May. Please inform the Parish Office of your desire to do so so that you may be prepared to receive this Sacrament in time for this year's celebration with Bishop DaCunha.
