Contemporary Wedding Trends: Creating A Sacred Covenant or Putting on a Big Show? Recently, a prospective bride inquired what a wedding in Church might look like, as she had never been to one! Should we be surprised? Sadly, no, because contemporary trends are fast moving away from Church Weddings and more toward outdoor or commercial venues. If you read comments online as to why, you will hear that it is simply more convenient to have a ceremony in the same place as the reception so there's no gap in between for guests for whom the couples are trying to "create an experience"! You will also read that couples are simply not affiliated with "organized religion" nor are they willing to accept the requirements that many churches rightly have regarding formal marriage preparation, nor the restriction on timing, decorations, or attire that churches may impose. Yet the real question that is missed and which needs to be raised is what does being married at a beach, a country club, or other staged venue like Madison Square Garden with a friend or relative officiating really mean? That is a difficult question to answer and may vary with each couple who seek to overtly personalize and sometimes even make private their spoken promises! What we do know is that it doesn't mean what marrying "in the Church" means! While online comments speak of shopping around for a substantial aisle or a beautiful sanctuary, some complain about restrictions in changing the lighting or the décor of the Church as if it were a Hollywood set instead of a sacred space!! Couples who seek to marry here in our parish are told that while Christ the King Church is a beautiful ecclesiastical building, if it burnt down before the day of their wedding they could still get married "in the Church" because that means getting married in accordance with a now ancient tradition that defines marriage as a sacrament that therefore belongs not only to the couples who enter it but also to the community of believers in Jesus Christ whose brand of unconditional, unending love marriage is meant to be a living sign! Therefore, Christian couples rightly get married in a sacred place where the Cross of Christ looms large and before an altar where the Sacrifice of Christ is perpetuated for as he laid down his life for us all the groom and the bride are promising to lay down their lives one for the other, and acknowledge as they do that it is by God's grace that they will be able to keep their word as they remain faithful to one another forever! That is why the proper officiant is an ordained minister of the Church, and the

sacred covenant being established between the couple is created by standard vows that have been spoken by many generations of couples, which express a love that is permanent and unconditional, spoken before God and two official witnesses. Church Weddings therefore can be simple or elaborate depending on the number of attendants and attendees, but at their essential core they remain the same, and that is perhaps too very ordinary for those competing with others for the most personalized and memorable show a la Taylor Swift and Travis Kelce at Madison Square Garden transformed at no little expense into a garden! Yet the Church rightly tries to reign in the elaborate and discourages the overly expensive while it emphasizes the essential as it reminds couples of the very sobering truth that a wedding is merely for a day, but a marriage is meant for a lifetime; therefore, the required preparation to covenant a sacramental marriage which many contemporary couples claim to resent is actually equally as important as the wedding celebration itself!
